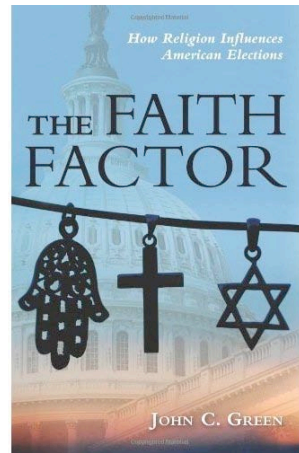
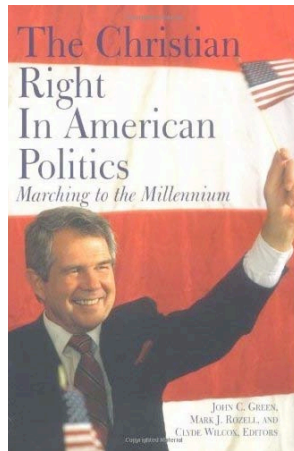


The Faith Factor: Religion and Politics in 2010
