

## **Life After Graduation Study**

On a yearly basis, Career Services conducts a survey to study the career paths of Wooster graduates. Questionnaires are sent to College of Wooster graduates one year after their graduation. Three mailings yielded a record return rate of 63% for the Class of 2001.

This report covers the following areas for the Class of 2001: *Summary Statistics, Employment, and Graduate School Information*. We hope this report will serve as a reference guide for all faculty, staff, students, parents, and alumni interested in career-related statistics for recent Wooster graduates.

Wooster graduates continue to be successful with employment in a variety of industries as well as acceptance into a diverse number of graduate school programs. The current status of the Class of 2001 is as follows:

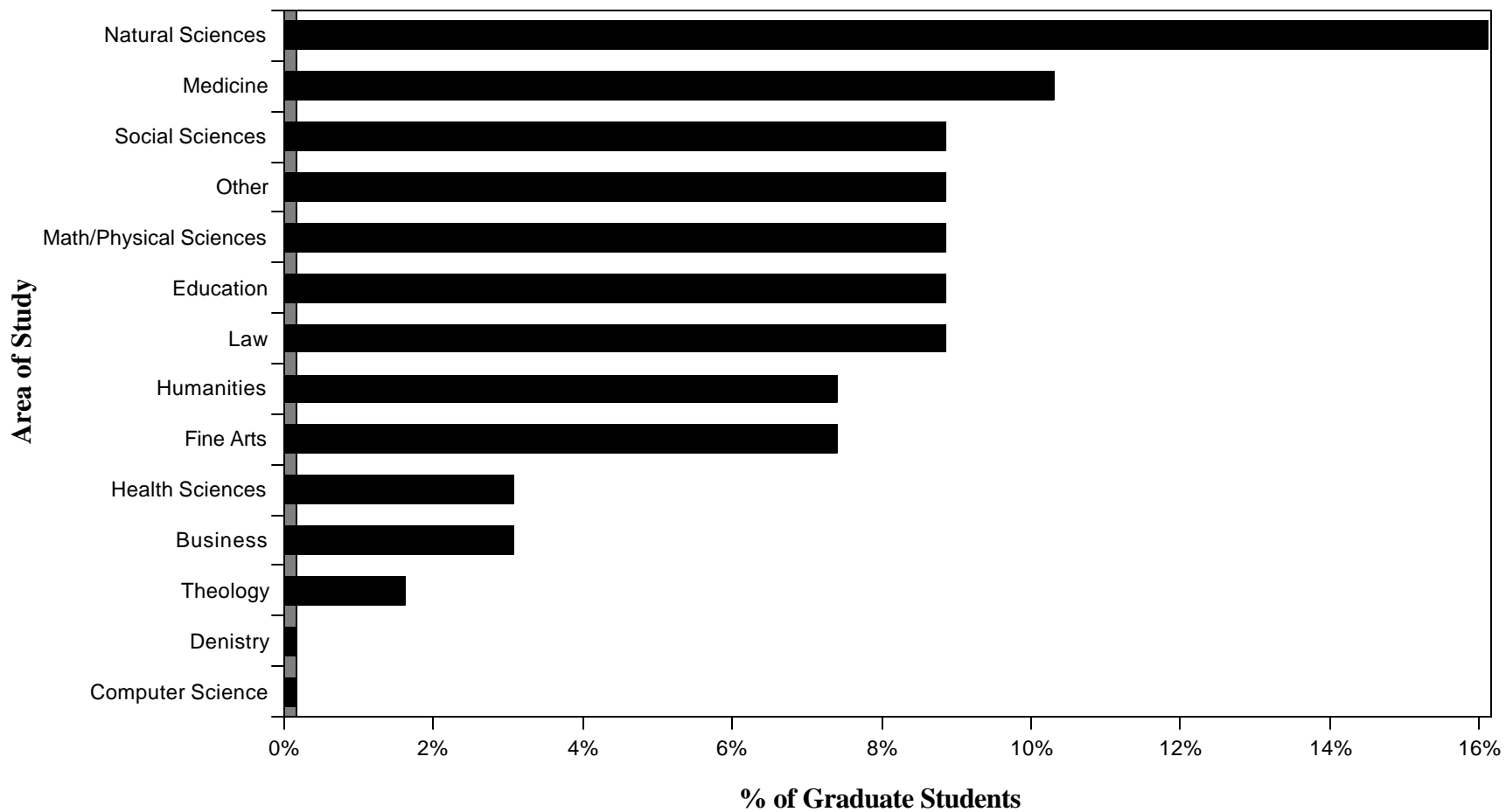

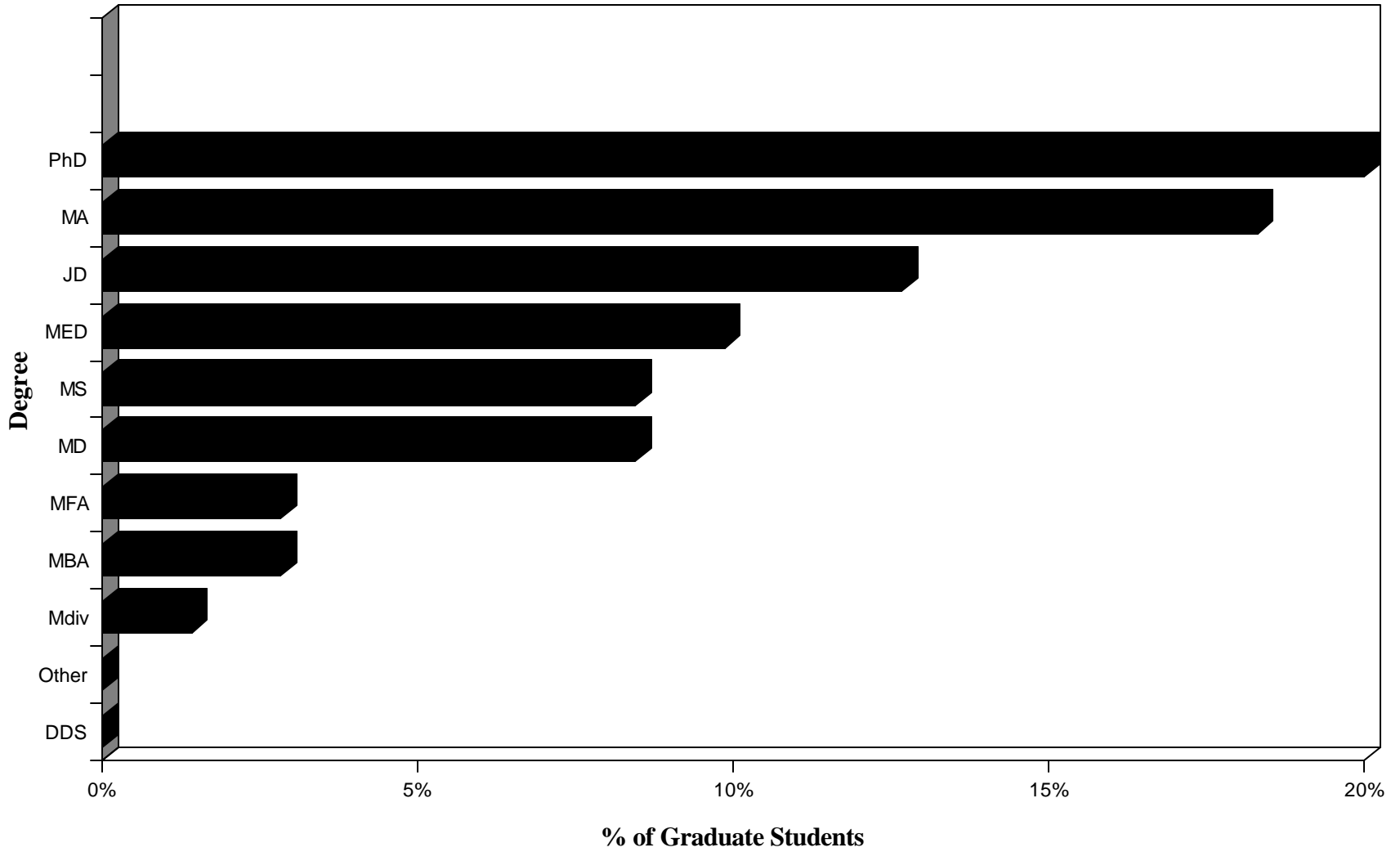

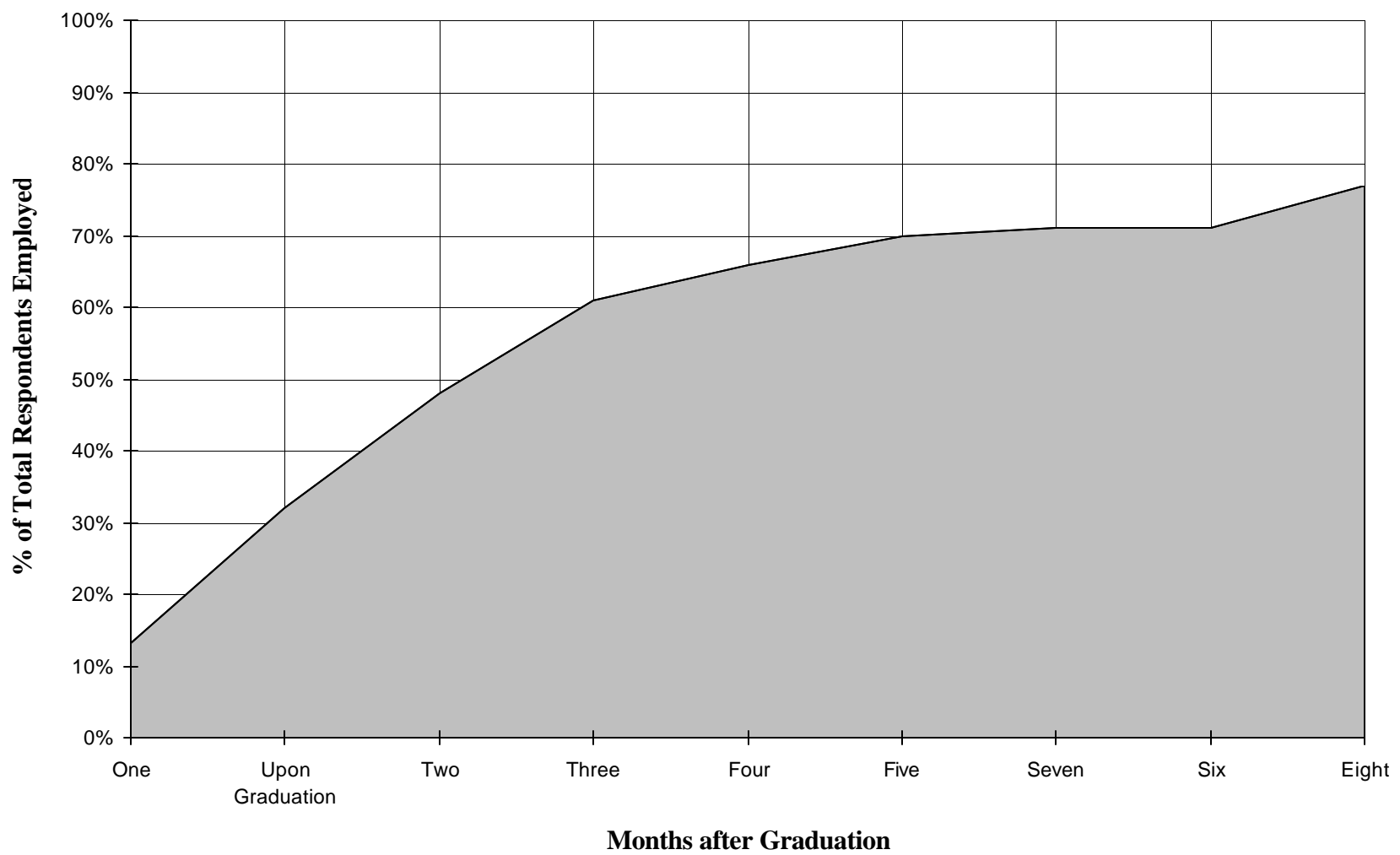

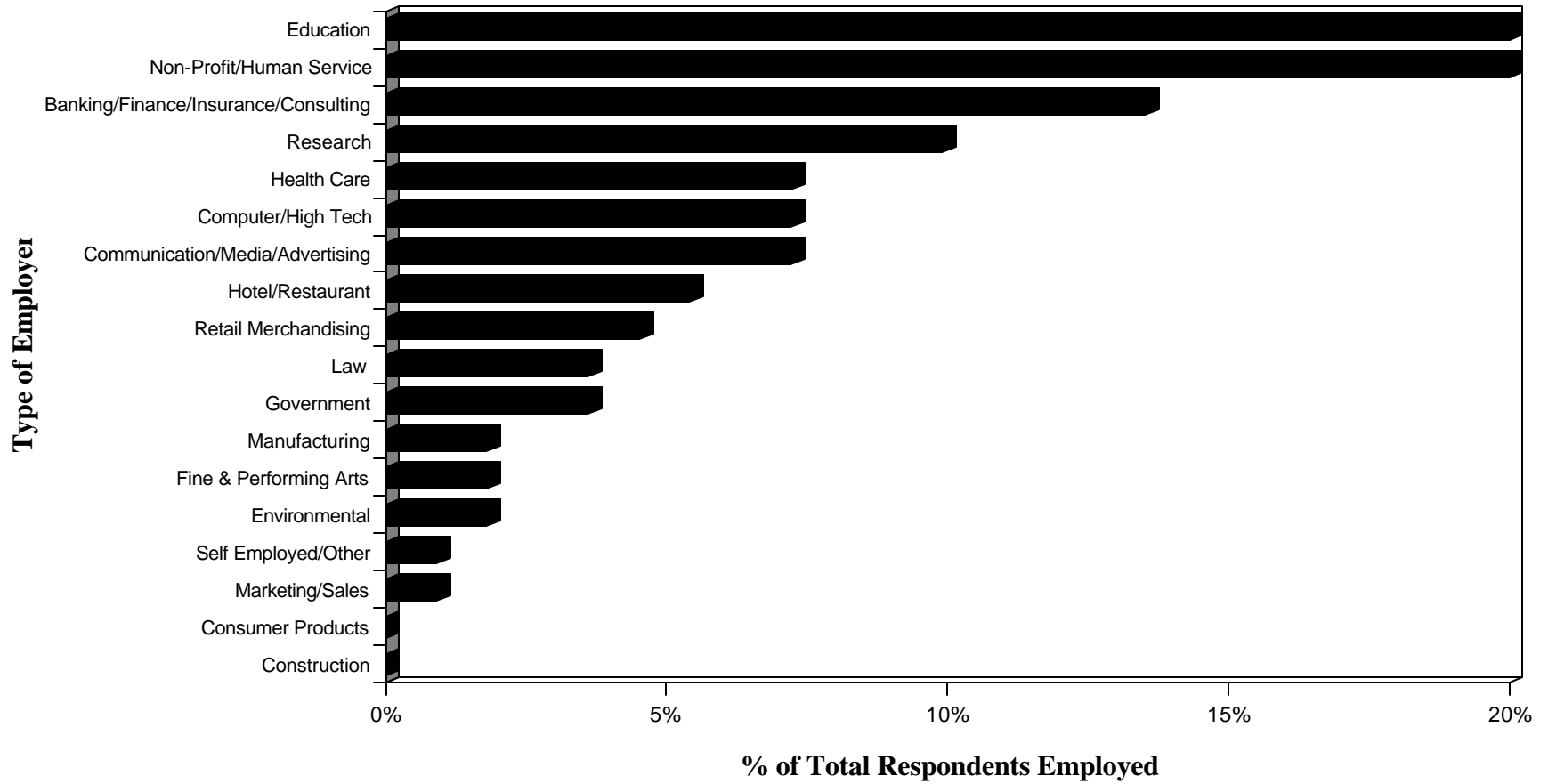
## Degrees Sought in Graduate Studies
