I am the evening nurse at the Wellness Center. This means that I generally answer the door, sign the students in, pull their charts, assess their problem, to decide whether it is something that I can deal with, or if I need to call the doctor, set up an appointment, put them to bed, or send them to the emergency room. I answer the phone, make appointments, care for overnight students, complete the students' medical records relating to visits, call appointment reminders, and track all x-rays and non-lab testing.
