Family Education Rights & Privacy Act (FERPA) Release

Instructions: Please read the definition of the Family Education Rights & Privacy Act (FERPA). **Students complete Part A OR Parents complete Part B.** Return the completed form to a staff member.

Definition: The Family Educational Rights & Privacy Act (FERPA) is a federal law that protects the privacy of student education records, both financial and academic. For the student's protection, FERPA limits release of student record information without the student's explicit written consent; however, it also gives the student's parent(s)/guardian the right to review those records if the parent(s)/guardian claim the student as a dependent on their federal income tax return.
